Introduction

The Schouten Foundation was established on 26 February 2019 at Burgstraat 12, Giessen.

The Foundation was initiated by a business group called Cornelia Johanna. The Cornelia Johanna group consists of five companies:

The group proposed the idea of setting up a foundation because they want to invest not only in the growth of their various companies, but also in a better life for those facing difficulties and fewer opportunities, locally and internationally. In doing this, the group reflects their Christian identity and fulfils their responsibility as Christians.

Mission/Vision

The Schouten Foundation wants to share its wealth with others by supporting projects that contribute to people's physical and spiritual well-being.

The Schouten Foundation uses the Bible as a reference point for its actions.

Strategy

We provide financial support to projects that align with the Schouten Foundation's goals.

To determine whether a project fulfils the Foundation's goals, we have set the following criteria:

- 1) Projects are selected based on their track record and proven commitment
- 2) The project plan must be clearly outlined and include objectives, activities, a budget, and the ultimate intended impact
- 3) The amount granted will be transferred only via the Schouten Foundation's bank account to the selected project

The social development work and its ongoing progress will be detailed in the Schouten Foundation's annual report, which consists of a financial report and a narrative report.

Current situation and plan

The foundation seeks to achieve its goals through financial support for projects such as:

On an international level:

- Sponsoring children to fulfil basic needs and education
- Providing skills training to men and women for better employment opportunities
- Contributing to Bible translations
- Contributing to radio broadcasts with a Christian message in hard-to-reach areas
- Supporting Bible distribution

Nationally and regionally:

- Supporting Christian youth work
- Supporting companions for people with physical and mental disabilities

Organization

The board consists of a chairman, a treasurer, a secretary, and two board members.

The Schouten Foundation has five board members, three of which are Schouten family members.

The board fulfils their duties on a 100% voluntary basis and receives no remuneration for said work.
